Bluffton University will play host to Kalamazoo College in its 2006 home opener. The Beavers are coming off a pair of road losses and are looking forward to Bluffton University Community Day in the friendly confines of Salzman Stadium.

## The Coaches

Bluffton head coach Greg Brooks enters his fourth year at the helm of the Bluffton University football team. Brooks previously served as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for Bluffton, leading the Beavers to their best offensive seasons in school history.

Terrance Brooks is entering his second season as head coach of the Hornets following a three-year stint as the assistant head coach at Shenandoah University (Va.). He led the Hornets to a three-game improvement and unblemished mark at home in his first season at Kalamazoo. In 2006, Brooks was one of 20 coaches selected to attend the NCAA Football Coaching Academy.

## Series History

This afternoon marks the fifth gridiron contest between Kalamazoo College of the MIAA and Bluffton University of the HCAC. The Beavers dominated the last meeting, 33-0, in 1987.

## Last Week

The Bluffton University football team went to the road for its second straight game and fell, 17-6, to a hungry Adrian College squad that was shut out in the first game at its new Multi-Purpose Performance Stadium a week before by the Defiance College Yellow Jackets, 10-0. Although the Bulldogs were without the services of Head Coach Lyall, who sat out the contest due to health reasons, Adrian took advantage of the clock to drop the Beavers to 0-2 for the 2006 season.

The Kalamazoo College football team traveled to Austin College in Texas for its 2006 season opener on Saturday, September 16. The Hornets knotted the contest at the 6:18 mark when Tim Kaselitz snuck it in from the one-yard line. After going ahead 14-10 midway through the second quarter, Kalamazoo gave up a one-yard touchdown run with two minutes to play in the first half which turned out to be the final score in the contest as the Hornets fell, 17-14.

## Next up for the Beavers

Bluffton will travel to Franklin to tackle the Grizzlies in its HCAC opener on Sat., September 30, 2006. Kickoff is scheduled for 1:30 p.m.
