Degree completion involves completing requirements in three areas of work: the Bluffton University Enduring Values requirements, a major with Bluffton University and any elective hours needed to meet the required total of 124 semester hours. Students will be granted a maximum of 62 hours for credit from Faith Builders Institute.
